Responses To Grand Jury Report

R1. We receive payment by check and that is adequate. We do not have the infrastructure or budget to accept different forms of payment. We do not have an office or even a computer or phone.

R2. We will contact San Luis Obispo County regarding a website that would have a phone number contact and email contact. Otherwise we do not have a website.

R3. We have board meetings as necessary but not every three months (not enough activity to warrant).

R4. As far as we know the site is as safe as possible. This site is a primitive natural undeveloped site. Therefore, there exist certain inherent dangers such as uneven ground, poison oak and rattlesnakes. Downed trees are removed regularly. Brush is cleared away yearly by volunteers.

R6. We will investigate liability insurance with San Luis Obispo County.

R7. Stipends are not necessary. We have no trustees and no employees. No payments are made to anyone.

R8. We will contact San Luis Obispo about the grant system however our need for funds is very minimal; perhaps for the liability insurance.

R9. There is plenty of room for more burials. No scatter areas required.
